Western Anadarko Basin Saltwater Disposal Assets Opportunity



Investment Highlights

- Spitfire Energy Group is selling its assets in the Western Anadarko Basin, including 14 saltwater disposal wells with an operational capacity of 125,000 Bpd.
- Underutilization of Spitfire's assets in a region with great need for disposal volumes provides excellent upside opportunity.
- Texas RRC not currently approving and/or restricting capacity for Brown Dolomite disposal wells in Spitfire's operational area.
- Total replacement cost for Spitfire's facilities exceeds \$75MM (3rd party estimate).
- The assets are projected to generate \$15.2MM of asset-level EBITDA on \$27.6MM of revenue over the next three years with modest development (1-rig).
- Under a more robust drilling program (3-rig), the assets are projected to generate \$37.1MM of asset-level EBITDA on \$59.1MM of revenue over the next three years. The predecessor to Presidio averaged 8-13 rigs for >3 years in the development area.






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
Opportunity Overview

Spitfire Energy Group LLC ("Spitfire" or the "Company") provides saltwater disposal services and infrastructure to oil and gas companies in the Western Anadarko Basin.

- Spitfire operates 14 strategically-located, commercial saltwater disposal ("SWD") facilities with a total operational disposal capacity of 125,000 BPD in the Western Anadarko Basin ("WAB") in Texas and Oklahoma.
- The Spitfire disposal operations also include 168 miles of gathering pipeline.
- The SWD facilities handle both piped and trucked saltwater/flowback for E&P customers operating in the WAB.
- Spitfire's SWDs are in compliance and current on their H-5 mechanical integrity tests.
- Spitfire's SWDs are in an excellent position with excess capacity available to capture the great need for water disposal in their operational area.

Spitfire maintains a network of 14 commercial saltwater disposal facilities in Hemphill (6), Wheeler (6), Oldham (1) and Potter (1) Counties, TX.










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Transaction Process Overview
